



The Staked Plain referred to in Chapter 11 is also known as the **Llano Estacado** is a level, semiarid, grassy, treeless plain. The High Plains, at 3600 feet, are centered on present day Amarillo. The South Plains begin around Lubbock and are at 2500 feet. Spooked by locomotives and constant east-west traffic, the buffalo made their last stand on the High Plains of the Texas Panhandle.
